

N.N.S. COVID-19 PREPAREDNESS PLAN

- 1. All staff shall follow Protocol as described by Mn. Health Dept. before reporting to work at N.N.S.. * See document enclosed**
- 2. N.N.S. will follow the recommendations of the CDC in the event of a confirmed case of Covid-19 in the building. Risk will be assessed and may be followed by a 2-5 day closing of the program for cleaning.**
- 3. Cleaning and disinfecting of the classrooms and outdoor playground will be done on a daily basis by both staff and the cleaning staff each day.
* see enclosed documents**
- 4. Social distancing of families shall be encouraged at drop-off and pick-up times daily. We will apply marks to the floor, spread out families down our hall or plan for playground drop-off and pick-up**
- 5. Families will be asked health questions on a daily basis including the child's temperature, general health concerns, and the overall health of their home family. We may choose to take temperature readings as staff.**
- 6. Teachers shall keep a log recording the above information (child's temp., health concerns, family health)**
- 7. Teachers shall exclude any child who is not within the health guidelines.**
- 8. Teachers and or children and their families will be asked to report to the school any confirmed cases of Covid-19 within their families or themselves.**
- 9. The Northfield United Methodist Church will be notified of any confirmed cases or exposure to Covid-19**
- 10. All documents and protocol directions will be available to parents and others on demand and as part of orientation to enroll at N.N.S..**
